


WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices

October 2015



The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.

WSU Current Index of Economic Activity

The current index declined somewhat between July and August, reversing previous improvements. This brought the current level of economic activity slightly below the 2014 level. The deterioration can be attributed to the decrease in total non-farm employment. The small improvements in the other index components were not enough to offset the decrease in employment.

WSU Leading Index of Economic Activity

The leading index deteriorated slightly between July and August and continues to indicate there will be a decrease in economic activity through the beginning of next year. This will potentially bring economic activity below the 2014 level. There has been a slight improvement in the Kansas Leading Index. However, the International Leading Index is at its lowest point since spring of 2013.
