


# WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices

## April 2015



The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.

### WSU Current Index of Economic Activity

The current index improved slightly between January and February, reversing the January decline. This improvement brought the current level of economic activity slightly above the February 2014 level. The improvement can be attributed to strong increases in the hours and earnings of production employees.

#### WSU Leading Index of Economic Activity

The leading index indicates there will be a slight improvement in economic activity in mid-summer. This will potentially bring economic activity above the 2014 level. This improvement in the leading index can be attributed to continuing small improvements in the Aircraft Production Index.
