


WSU Wichita Metropolitan Area Indices

June 2015



The Center for Economic Development and Business Research has compiled the current and leading indices to provide insights into the present and future state of the Wichita economy. The WSU Current Conditions Index is designed to give an indication of the present conditions of the Wichita metropolitan area economy. The WSU Leading Economic Indicators Index is designed to give an indication of where the Wichita economy is headed over the next six months.

WSU Current Index of Economic Activity

The current index was improved slightly between March and April, reversing the deterioration from February to March. The currently level of economic activity remains slightly above the April 2014 level. The improvement can be attributed to increases in employment and the earnings and hours of production workers. These improvements were enough to off-set the small increase in the unemployment rate.

WSU Leading Index of Economic Activity

The leading index improved slightly between March and April, although it is still indicating there will be a decrease in economic activity in early fall. This will potentially bring economic activity below the 2014 level. This can be attributed to small decreases in all of the index components.
